above, created by one of the graduating seniors, captures the deep importance of creative worship in camp and campus ministries for our students.

Campus ministry is vital for the church- but you don't have to only take this campus pastor's word for it. In February 2025, the ELCA released a <u>strategic</u> recommendation report compiled by data from Fuller Leadership Formation and Barna Group that recommends the following:

- 1) Cultivate congregations that are warmer, more inviting and more invitational in nature.
- 2) Enhance ELCA-wide efforts to nurture and strengthen faith and spiritual formation.
- 3) Tangibly and significantly incorporate and empower young people in all levels of the Church's life.
- 4) Provide greater empowerment, equipping and tools for lay leaders to carry out the work of ministry and be the Church in the world today.
- 5) Rethink, refocus and reorganize the ELCA's educational systems and structures to serve the current (and rapidly changing) needs of the ELCA.

Campus Ministry is mentioned 17 times, both in ways that the church is already doing things well and as well as place to invest further resources. If you're part of Lutheran faith communities and circles, it's worth a read and conversation (in our humble opinion).
